Cameroonian migrants in Gabon

ガボンにおけるカメルーン人移住民

In a recent article, Oliver Bakewell raised the question why diaspora formation within the African continent seems a rare incident to which little scholarly attention has been paid. In my contribution I will take up his suggestion to look into the presence or absence of diaspora formation within Africa and the reasons that could account for it.

My explorations will focus on Mbororo (pastoral Fulbe) migrants from Cameroon based in Gabon. While looking at their livelihoods and transnational relations, I will also analyze their legal situation and concurrent reflections on identity.
