To achieve sustainable development in rural tropical Africa, it is necessary to reconcile the wise use of the natural environment and its conservation.

Although the principle is simple, the reality in terms of local sociology and environmental conditions is so diverse that we have yet to understand how rural Africans construct their livelihoods and epistemology of the surrounding environment.
